1. Address of Hotel St. Josef

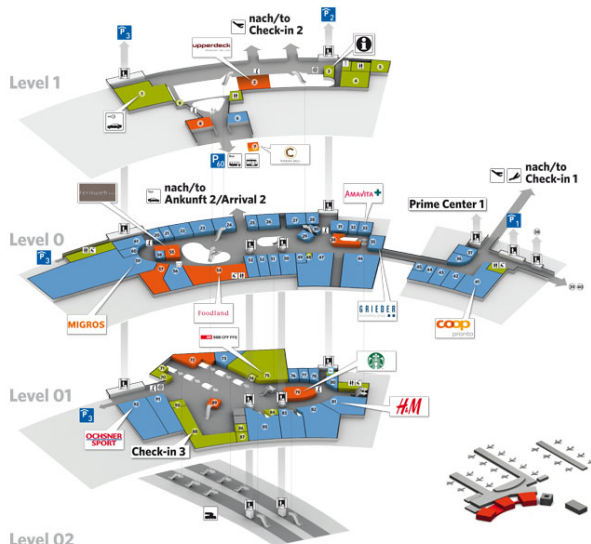

Directions from Zurich Airport to Zurich Main Station:

Please go to Level 01 where you can buy tickets (at the machine or SBB Rail Service) to Zürich city. A single ticket costs CHF 6.60 and covers travel in zones 110 and 121 (City of Zurich and Airport). You can also buy your tickets online (www.sbb.ch/abos-billette/e-tickets), but the ticket is only valid for the exact hour you register for when booking the ticket.



Most trains to Zurich leave from Platform 1 or 2 (Level 02). Alternatively, you can take tram 10 to 'Central', which leaves from Level 1 (ticket machines available).

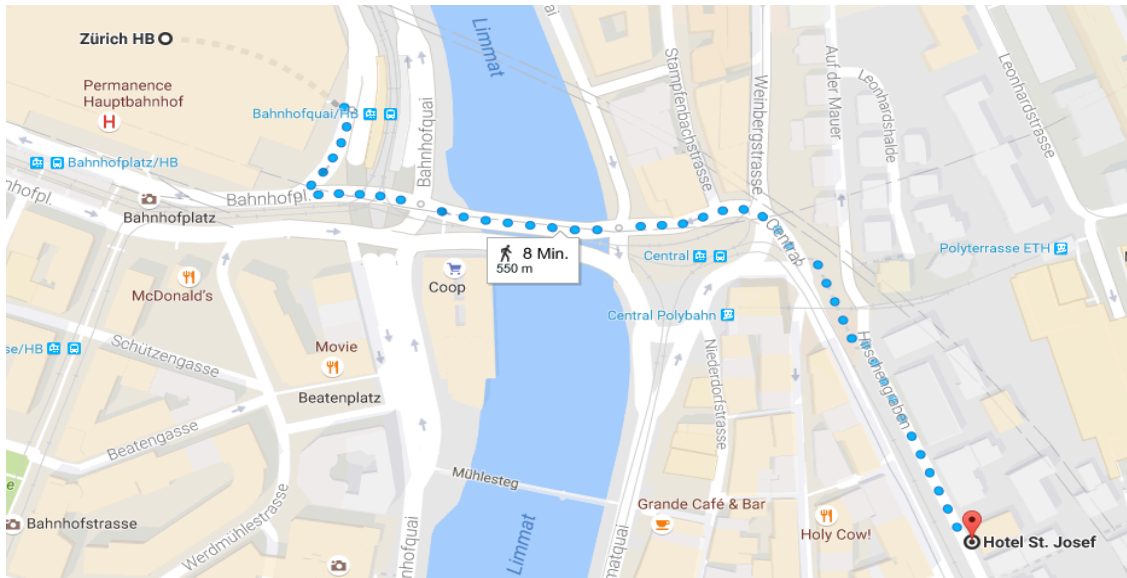

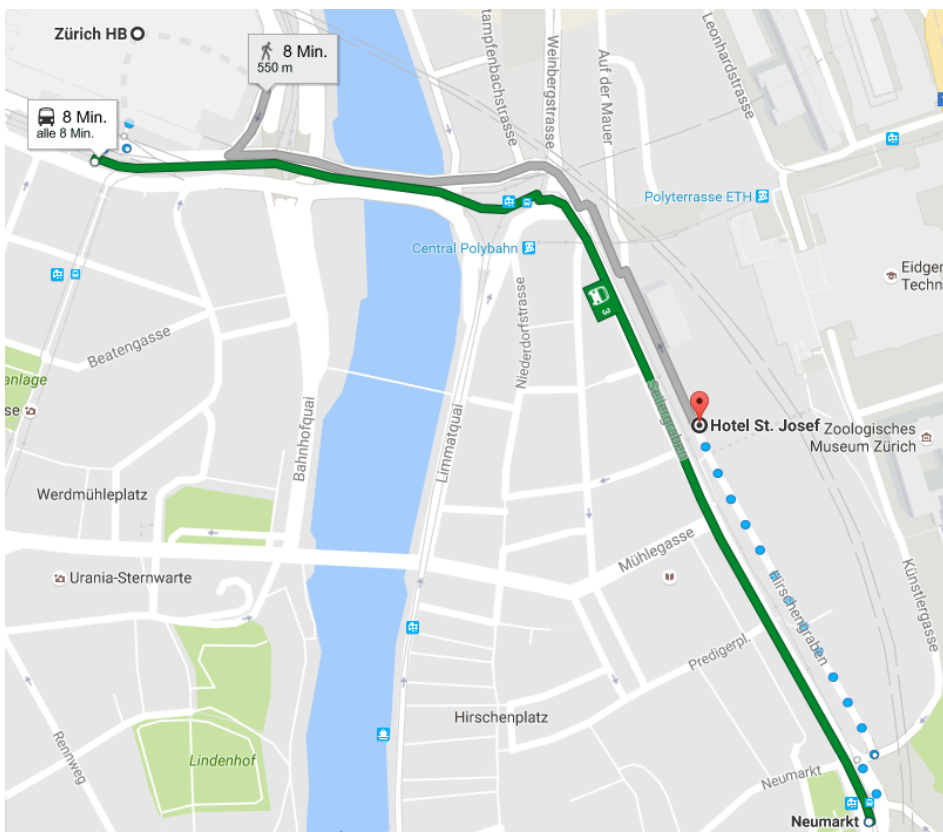

Directions from Zürich Main Station to Hotel St. Josef:

Cross the hall of the train station and leave through the exit 'Bahnhofquai' (tram stop). Cross the bridge to Central. Cross Central and walk up the steps on to the road above the wall (Hirschengraben). The Hotel St. Josef is situated a short distance along this road. To avoid the steps, walk along underneath the wall (Seilergraben) after about 150 m there is a ramp up to the 'Hirschengraben'.



Alternatively, you can take tram 3 (direction "Klusplatz") from the station or 'Central' to 'Neumarkt' and walk up the Hirschengraben from there.

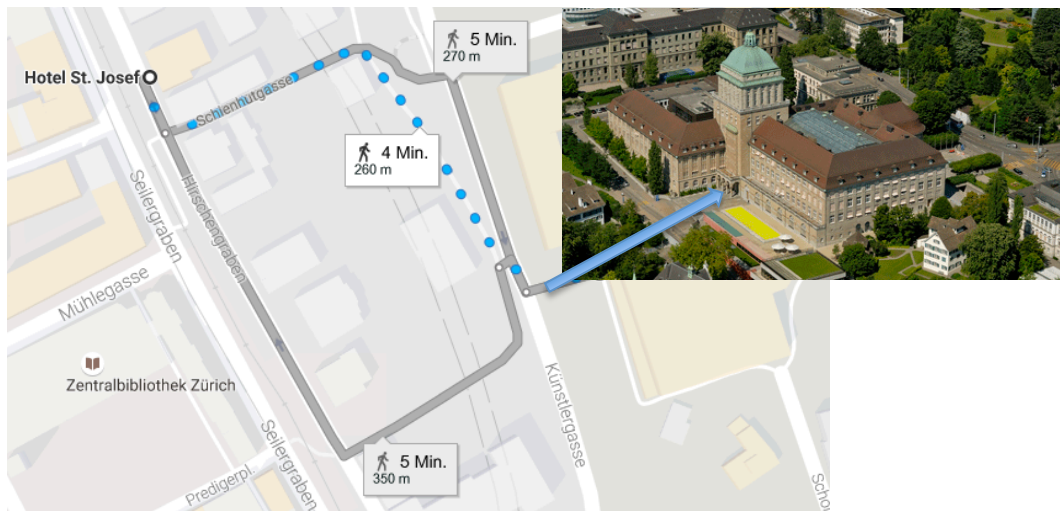
2. Address of conference venue/room

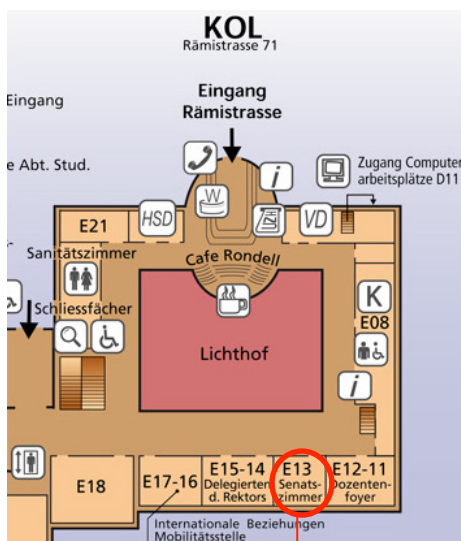
